

FSA/HSA Eligible Over The Counter Items

Effective January 1, 2020

NEW! Effective <u>January 1, 2020</u>, the IRS allows for the reimbursement of Over-the-Counter (OTC) medicines or drugs to be purchased with Health Care FSA or Health Savings Accounts (HSA) funds. There is no need for a prescription or doctor's note. You may utilize your HG Advantage Card for these purchases.

- Baby Formula/Nutritionals
- Fluoride Treatments
- Hair Growth Products
- Herbals & Botanicals
- Vitamins & Vitamin Supplements
- Weight Control Supplements
